



MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

Honorable Judge Reger,

I am requesting a judicial release upon my 5 year qualification date. My 5 years is up 1/15/2025. I am requesting an early hearing so that I can continue to attend Ashland University under a Federal Pell Grant rather than the State of Ohio paying for it since the next semester begins on January 21, 2025. Upon my entry into CRC in 2020, I was classified a level 1 with a low risk recidivism score and no risk for drug abuse. Upon my entry into Richland it remained the same for almost 5 years. I was never given a case plan for rehabilitation.

I have been fortunate that I have been able to help teach several classes. Since day one I have spent every day doing what I could to help educate and support others in hope they can also become better people. I have sent you some facilitator assessments for reference. I am a certified tutor and facilitator. I have worked outside of the prison grounds on the creation of an urban farm and at the Ashland county fairgrounds. I am currently enrolled in Ashland University seeking a degree in organizational leadership while taking courses in communications, management, accounting, and English.

My mother was diagnosed with cancer while I was at CRC and she passed before I got the chance to speak to her due to Covid. My daughter graduated college and my other daughter got married and had two kids. These are times I should have been there for. I continue to speak to several current and past PHCA board member and Steve Kramer wishes to speak on my behalf with the potential for more. I have included a character reference letter from Mr. Kramer as well. All of these letters from friends and family include their contact information for verification. I had them all send the letters to me so that I could make sure they got to you in one piece.

I hope that you see that I wasted none of my time here. I hope that you will read and take into consideration all of my motion.

To whom it concerns,

I think we're past the point of asking whether or not Harold Jason Craig is guilty or not guilty. This letter would be wasted if I were to spend writing about the supposed crime he committed without a complaining victim. And now we're on to asking ourselves whether the time he has spent in prison has been enough? Is Harold a danger to society if he were to be released? I've always thought that everything happens for a reason, there is a lesson learned, that god gives us what we can handle.

Let's start with the good, being in prison is a life changing experience for anyone. Jason, was able to continue his education, get certifications, he's learned a lot about agriculture and gardening, and was able to touch lives of many prisoners for the better. I personally was able to go to a "Because I said I would" graduation where I met and heard stories of prisoners who with the help of Jason who was their course instructor, and made promises to themselves and their families to better themselves. He also has helped with a lot of legal work, including writing judicials that helped many get out and reunite with their family. But now, it's Jason's turn.

Since 2020, when Jason first went into prison many things have happened on "the outside" that nobody will ever get back. This was the year of the pandemic, and with that Susan Craig (Jason's mother) was placed in hospice and eventually passed away. I was there the last time she was able to speak with Jason where she was so unoriented but that is what he gets to remember as his last memory. A phone call, with interruptions of a recording of the constant reminder of where his is. A phone call that has time limits and time restrictions. A last conversation with his dying mother, cut off. No hug, no kiss, no real final goodbye.

Later that year, I had my first child. Jason's first grandchild. A beautiful little girl who now calls him Pap Pap, because she couldn't say Papaw. He missed so much time and memories with her due to covid restrictions. Then 2021, I brought a second baby girl into the world. Both now get to look back at photos and ask where are we with Pap Pap? Where does Pap Pap live? And now in visitation they ask to play outside with him or on phone calls asking why they can't see Pap Pap because they love to FaceTime everyone. These are hard things to explain to a now 3 and 4 year old who still haven't got to be pushed on the swings by their grandfather. They have so many firsts, so many birthdays, so many memories that they never got to experience with him. Unfortunately I've also had some losses, 2 miscarriages where I couldn't have the support of my father there.

April 9th 2022, I got married to my highschool sweetheart and the father of my children. This is an event where every girl dreams of. Where they imagine the tears and hugs of their dad seeing them in their white wedding dress. Where their dad walks them down the aisle and gets to give them away. I have a photo album filled with pictures from that day without my dad in sight. I always imagined him being there and listening to "Butterfly kisses" by Bob Carlisle. Which also happens to be my first tattoo. I was given away by my Uncle who I'm thankful for being there, but there will also be that hole that can never be filled. That place my dad should have been, and I'm sure an embarrassing speech that will never be given.

Selfishly, I ask and plead to take into consideration an early release. I ask that you give a daughter back her dad, that you give 2 granddaughters back their Pap Pap. I ask for his time served to be viewed as enough and the lessons learned to further the help he can give on the outside. I ask for you to give us more time together and for more memories to be made.

Who is Harold Jason Craig to you? A man who was accused and convicted of stealing over \$250,000 from a community center that he gave his complete heart and life too. A man who is "malicious" and an "evil genius". A man who lied and faked his way through years of running a community center for children. A man who deserved to spend 7 years of his life behind bars for something he did not do.

Jason Craig has always dedicated his time and efforts to education and better the lives of others. The entire time he was in charge of the PHCA he did just that. All the fundraising, events, etc were for the children. He wanted to be able to turn the PHCA around from an after school daycare/play-place, to an educational building to help with the struggle of the children growing up in the heights uneducated. Not many children ever experienced the honor roll, or even passing classes with a C or higher. Once the educational programs started to play out this slowly changed. This was the goal.

Now, who is Harold Jason Craig to me? He is Jason. He is someone I look up to. He is my hero. He is my dad.

Who am I? My name is Taylor Craig, I currently reside in Perrysburg Ohio, working as a Registered Dental Hygienist, with a goal to better the lives and health of people around the area. Something I learned from my father.

Never once in my life did I think I would lose my dad at the age of 19. Although I did not lose him completely from my life, he was gone for so many things I needed him for. He was unable to see me graduate not only from Cosmetology school, but Dental Hygiene School. I was able to complete 2 programs and graduate with a Associates in Applied Science. I was able to become a Dental hygienist while he sat in a prison to rot, only able to imagine being able to be at all those events in his child's life.

He had to experience and grieve the loss of his mother while incarcerated. Unable to speak to her due to call times and Covid regulations lining up. He wasn't there for the birth of not 1 but the 2 of his grandchildren. He had to see them grow up from minimal pictures and videos. Not able to meet them for some time because of age limitations for visiting. The events and moments that had to be missed due to this wrongful incarceration are terrific.

Even with all the people who have done him wrong he is still looking forward to coming out of that prison and continuing his journey with helping people. The goals and plans are switched to a different population of people but that same person still resides. Prison changed him for the better and the worse. He was able to see the justice system play out firsthand and help many prisoners with their cases, education, lives, etc. But all of this at the expense of him living a free life. Him being able to experience being a friend, father, grandfather to the people that needed him the most.

Please consider all the wonderful things he has not only done before he was incarcerated but all of the programs he created and ran to help out other inmates. Please consider the "crime committed" vs the time he has been incarcerated. It's time for Harold Craig to be released. It's time for my dad to come home. Thank you.

Who am I and how do I know Jason? I am a retired professor of mechanical engineering from The University of Toledo. In retirement I have been a volunteer tutor helping students at Perrysburg High School in all math and science subjects. I do this via ZOOM every most evening.

I met Jason in 2010 while I was a board of trustees member of the Perrysburg Heights Community Association. I am still on the board but I am not speaking on their behalf. Rather I am just giving you my opinion of Jason's character.


Jason lived in the Perrysburg Heights neighborhood (just east of Levis Commons). Since he was only three blocks away, Jason was seen at the Center many days of the week. Not just because his two young daughters participated there, but because of all the kids. At first, Jason willingly helped create and maintain our brand-new garden. He also led a few activities with many kids at the Center. Because of Jason's willingness and success with the kids, he was invited by our president to join the board the very next year. He did so and as board members he and I interacted many times thereafter.

Jason is an intelligent, strong willed, caring and sensitive man. He cares for all of the kids (at the time: 2nd thru 9th graders mostly) at the Center. He used his leadership and educational skills to encourage them to do their homework, to do it well, and to take pride in completing it correctly. He is a big believer in the Golden Rule and impressed that on the kids. He encouraged and helped them form friendships among themselves. These friendships often crossed socio-economic, ethnic and racial boundaries. As a consequence many long term friendships have carried thru to high school. Jason often uses humor (appropriate for kids) to make a point. Kids have always admired him, sought him out and willingly offered him their assistance (gardening, weeding, watering, taking out the trash, and so forth). In addition, Jason interacted well with adults. He is a straight shooter – with high standards of honesty and integrity.

I am told Jason is taking classes at Ashland University studying Organizational Leadership. I also am told he is a facilitator at the prison. Meaning: he has the respect of fellow prisoners and administrators; another testament to his character.

In summary, I have always believed Jason is a quality individual. He is, and will continue to be, a credit to society.

To whom it may concern:

This letter is written to address the charges that were brought upon Harold "Jason" Craig stemming from his involvement with the Perrysburg Heights Community Center.

First, a little background about my relationship to the center as well as Jason. I run Toledo Sport and Social Club, a business that offers recreational sports play to adults in and around the Toledo area. In August of 2012, my relationship started with PHCA as a renter of the facility for an adult basketball league. My renting continued until the Winter of 2015. In that time, I paid roughly \$31k in rent for the facility. During this time, I got to know Jason well.

Jason is definitely an interesting person. There is no "hustle" that does not interest him, but that is just it about Jason. He is willing to work whatever system is in place to earn a buck, but I truly honestly doubt he would ever take something from someone without providing something in return and therefore, I do not believe he stole from the community center.

I believed that so much that even after our relationship at the center ended and he moved temporarily to Cleveland, Ohio, I rented one of my condos to him. During the time he was renting from me, I never had to worry about the rent being paid and he was a model tenant.

The charges brought upon Jason do not make sense to me on several levels. First and foremost, having spent a short amount of time on the board and as president for a little bit, there was not a surplus of money to be stolen, let alone, even pay the bills. During my time on the board, I paid attention to what was being paid for our utilities and our revenue streams. For the most part, there was revenue from facility rental (mine as a renter) and a few other small events. In addition to the facility rental money, there was the Toledo Community Foundation Endowment money, but we were only allowed to withdraw at most \$30k a year... Honestly, I do not know the terms or how we could reach that money but the balance in the TCF funds never dropped by anything significant during my time, so I am not sure we even withdrew from it more than maybe once.

The second reason and one that I never dug into, but I believe is the error in this process is simply accounting. The Visalis sales were before my time but as I understood the process, product would be purchased and then sold right away. The money made from the sales of Visalis were put right back into product turnover. The only money generated in surplus of purchasing product was through commissions paid by Visalis for making sales goals and being a "distributor". If anyone should be upset about the set-up Jason had put in place with Stephanie Serda and others, it would be Visalis. They were paying commission to distributors who had distributors under them helping the pyramid make more on commission. When it comes to the Visalis "stuff" I can certainly say I do not know all or even a partial amount of the details. However, I believe in the time the attorney general was contacting me, I was being shown only the sales side of the transactions and not the funds being put right back into purchasing product to sell again.

That all being said, I am still confused and mystified that this process has led to a conviction of Jason. I didn't step forward to defend or condemn Jason in the past because I have no proof to show either way. But what I can say for certain, is that there wasn't extra money around the community center when I was there, and I sincerely doubt Jason could have stolen the money he was charged with stealing.

To whom it may concern,

My name is Scott Steffes and I am writing concerning the character of Harold Jason Craig and his Judicial release request. In the years I have been incarcerated, Jason has been a big part of me being able to cope with life in prison. I met him when I first came to prison as the guy I had to go to for programming. Our case manager, staff, and Sergeant all told me that Jason was the man to see. I met Jason in the back room that the staff gave to him as an office. He was the only person that was taking time to teach people from 5 upper. He tutored guys who could not read, he facilitated Roots of Success, Houses of Healing, Because I said I Would, and quite a few other programs. Like I said, 5 upper did not really have anyone to care about us. I took I believe 3 of his classes and they were great. Jason took no bull. If the class did not pay attention, he would throw everyone out. If guys were late, no class. No one even tried to buy a certification from him because everyone knew he wouldn't have it. I learned a lot from Jason, but there are two things that really stuck out to me. First, I am a gay man and did not have an easy time when I first got here. Fortunately for me, Jason had respect from everyone because of how he treated everyone. While in his classes, he made us act as a family and he made us understand each other. He always told us that we do not know how others environments were and we need to think before we judge.

Jason always motivated us to do good things. He would somehow get us to volunteer for deep cleaning, recycling, painting, and anything the staff ask him to organize. He tried to get people to change their behaviors so they could have some of the honors he was given. Finally, the most impressive thing about Jason is how he handled controversy. Earlier 2024, an inmate overdosed in Jason's cubicle. I remember Jason pulling him on the floor and administering CPR, yelling for staff. Jason had just studied CPR on his tablet. When staff took over, Jason ran to the locked door and waited for medical to arrive. Our Unit Manager arrived and Jason told her to get the narcan. She did not do it. After about 5 minutes Jason was screaming to get the narcan. Finally additional staff arrived and Jason convinced them to administer narcan. After 4 doses the inmate was revived and sent to the hospital for a narcan drip. He has snorted straight fentanyl. Two days later Jason was moved by the unit manager to another house for embarrassing her. He would not give up on us and finished teaching our class outside on the rec yard. We all graduated Roots of Success 8 weeks later. The trouble he never regretted was always about doing the right thing. He got in trouble for getting mad that he was forced to break a promise and not volunteer at the fairgrounds and then he got in trouble for helping to keep a program going at the prison. He always wants to help us.

Just this last week, the staff, Sergeant, and the IOP rehabilitation supervisor, Ms. Geron, made a request to have him moved back to 5 house because he was so valuable. The truth is, it would be a big loss to Richland Correctional to lose Jason. His value to both the staff and us inmates is unlimited. The programs he has created and the hope he gives is inspiring. He deserves to go home. He always talks about his love for the people in his life. I truly believe that if the staff were allowed to write references, you would easily have 100 plus letters. Jason is not like the rest. He is rare in his ability to resist doing wrong and making others feel the need to do right.

Dear Judge Reger,

Hi. You don't know me and I don't know you. I'm assuming that given your position you've worked hard and had people around you to mentor you in your journey to the bench. I am sure you and your circle are proud of what you have accomplished so far in this life.

My brother, Jason, never had that. He's always been smart, creative, and funny. But he moved around so much as a child that he never really got to dig in roots and grow the support system he needed to become the man he could be.

We are two years apart, my brother and I, but we both remember being so poor as children that we didn't have running water or electricity during the summer. Then we went into foster care for the first time. Later, we went a second time.

Years later I can look back and remember how we never spent more than a year and a half in one place. I gave up on making friends, but my brother continued to reach out to show how much he wanted to belong.

I don't know the full truth of what happened at the Center. I know my brother is a good person who, at other times, helped raise money for a family whose house burnt down, who stopped to put out a burning car on the side of the road and pull its occupant to safety, who let his brother, me, stay in his house when I had nothing to offer.

I don't know if the punishment here fits the crime or not. I'm am neither lawyer nor judge. But I do know that when Jason is released he will try to right any wrongs that may have been done.

I didn't know what I was going to say when I sat down to do this. I just know how I felt. And I hope you can feel it also. There is no redemption for the incarcerated because there can never be true atonement. I hope that you will give him the chance find it.




